After 1945 the place was not used any more. The City of Rome bought it in 1977 and restored (*lira - Italian currency, used before euro)


Before you leave behind the main gate, Look at the two pillars. Now you state: There is a figure of a black ______ on each top. Solved? OK, let's go to the next stop!
